**THE ABOVE TEACHINGS ARE PLAINLY REVEALED IN GOD’S HOLY WORD.**

1 Kings 8:39: - “Then hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and forgive, and do, and give to every man according to his ways, **whose heart thou knowest; (for thou, [even] thou only, knowest the hearts of all the children of men;)**”

1 Chronicles 28:9: - “And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: **for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts:** if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.”

Job 31:4: - “Doth not he see my ways, and count all my steps?”

Job 34:21, 22: - “**For his eyes [are] upon the ways of man, and he seeth all his goings. [There is] no darkness, nor shadow of death, where the workers of iniquity may hide themselves.**”

Psalm 33:13 - 15: - **“The LORD looketh from heaven; he beholdeth all the sons of men. From the place of his habitation he looketh upon all the inhabitants of the earth. He fashioneth their hearts alike; he considereth all their works.”**

Psalm 69:5: - **“O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee.”**

Psalm 139:7 - 12: - **“Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence? If I ascend up into heaven, thou [art] there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou [art there]. [If] I take the wings of the morning, [and] dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me. If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me. Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light [are] both alike [to thee].”**

Proverbs 5:21: - **“For the ways of man [are] before the eyes of the LORD, and he pondereth all his goings.”**

Proverbs 15:3: - **“The eyes of the LORD [are] in every place, beholding the evil and the good.”**

Jeremiah 16:17: - **“For mine eyes [are] upon all their ways: they are not hid from my face, neither is their iniquity hid from mine eyes.”**

Jeremiah 23:24: - **“Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the LORD. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the LORD.”**

Jeremiah 32:17 - 19: - **“Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, [and] there is nothing too hard for thee: Thou showest lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompensest the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: **the Great, the Mighty God, the LORD of hosts, [is] his name, great in counsel, and mighty in work: for thine eyes [are] open upon all the ways of the sons of men: to give every one according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings.**”**

Hebrews 4:13: - **“Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things [are] naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.”**

- Adam and Eve attempted to hide from God in the Garden of Eden after their sin. Their efforts were in vain – See Genesis 3:6-10.
- The reluctant prophet Jonah tried to flee from God, even taking a journey by sea to get away from the Lord. He failed miserably in this attempt – See Jonah 1:1 - 10.
- There was an Unseen Heavenly Watcher at the drunken and idolatrous feast held by the Babylonian King Belshazzar. The Heavenly Watcher interrupted this wicked feast with a message of Divine Judgment that was executed that very night – See Daniel Chapter 5.

These Biblical truths should have a sobering effect upon how we live our lives. We must remember the inspired words of the wise man Solomon, and order our lives accordingly.

Ecclesiastes 8:11 - 13: - “Because sentence against an evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil. Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his [days] be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before him: But it shall not be well with the wicked, neither shall he prolong [his] days, [which are] as a shadow; because he feareth not before God.”

Ecclesiastes 12:13, 14: - “Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this [is] the whole [duty] of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether [it be] good, or whether [it be] evil.”
