AN EXAMINATION OF SOME OF THE HEBREW NAMES OF GOD IN THE OLD TESTAMENT SCRIPTURES: -

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NOTE: - All Bible texts have been taken from the <u>King James Version</u>; and the compiler has supplied all emphasis throughout this Study Document.

<u>Psalm 148:13: -</u> "Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven."

When one examines carefully the Hebrew names of God as recorded in the Old Testament writings, one soon finds that these various names are describing different characteristics of the one true God of the Old Testament. This <u>Study Document</u> while it will be thorough, it will not be exhaustive, in its listing every different Hebrew name of God. It is really quite revealing how these names describe many of the characteristics of God.

If we study these Scriptures aright, it will help us to have a deeper and more insightful understanding of the character of the only true God Christians worship. And to **truly** know Him, is life eternal according to the words of Jesus Christ.

John 17:3: - "And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent"

The most frequently occurring Hebrew singular word for "God" is the word ₹7 - "⁵el" - <u>Strong's Hebrew Number 410.</u>

- The One God ¹७६६ दे "El Echad" Malachi 2:10: "Have we not all one father? hath not one God created us? why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the covenant of our fathers?"
- The Faithful God ប៉ុស្ត់ដូក្សា ់ "Ha El Hanne'man" <u>Deuteronomy 7:9: -</u> " Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he *is* God, **the faithful God**, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations."
- The Just God אַרֹיק' "El Tsaddik" <u>Isaiah 45:21: -</u> "Tell ye, and bring [them] near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the LORD? and there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour; there is none beside me."

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¹ Please note, that Biblical Hebrew is read from right to left, and NOT left to right as in English.

- The Almighty God² "Tビ ' ' ' ' ' "El Shaddai" Genesis 17:1: "And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect."
- The Great God³ בְּלֵבֶּל לְלָבֶּל "HaEl Haggadol" <u>Deuteronomy 10:17: -</u> "For the LORD your God *is* God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward."
- The Most High God אָלְינֹן "El Elyon" Genesis 14:18 20: "And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God. And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth: And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all."
- The Mighty God⁴ "Li Gibbor" <u>Isaiah 9:6: -</u> "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, **The mighty God**, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace."
- The Everlasting God⁵ בֹּלֶבְׁלֵ **י"El Olam"** <u>Genesis 21:33: -</u> "And *Abraham* planted a grove in Beersheba, and called there on the name of the LORD, **the everlasting God**."
- The Holy God בְּלֶלְאֵ בּ "HaEl Hakkadosh" <u>Isaiah 5:16: -</u> "But the LORD of hosts shall be exalted in judgment, and *God that is holy shall be sanctified in righteousness."

<u>NOTE: -</u> The margin has two alternative translations for "God that is holy"; One, "Or, *the holy God";* or two, "Heb. *the God the holy".*

- The Gracious God רְבֹּלֵבְ "El-Channun" <u>Jonah 4:2: -</u> "And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil."
- The Merciful God בות אלי "El Rachum" Deuteronomy 4:31: "(For the LORD thy God is a merciful God;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them."

Revelation 1:7 & 8: - "Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty."

According to the principles of New Testament Greek grammar discovered by the Englsh scholar Granville Sharp in the 18th century, the highlighted portion of this verse should actually read as "of our great God and Saviour Jesus Christ."

<u>Isaiah 40:28: -</u> "Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, *that* **the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth,** fainteth not, neither is weary? *there is* no searching of his understanding."

² The Lord Jesus Christ is recognized in the New Testament as being **the Almighty**.

³ Titus 2:13 KJV translation: - "Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ."

- The Jealous God ፲፫ጵ ፫ን "El Kanno" Exodus 20:5: "Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me."
- The Terrible [in the sense of Awesome] God אָרָל "HaEl Hannora" Nehemiah 9:32: "Now therefore, our God, the great, the mighty, and the terrible God, who keepest covenant and mercy, let not all the trouble seem little before thee, that hath come upon us, on our kings, on our princes, and on our priests, and on our prophets, and on our fathers, and on all thy people, since the time of the kings of Assyria unto this day."
- The God who sees me⁶ אֵל ְרָאֵל "El Roi" Genesis 16:13: "And she called the name of the LORD that spake unto her, **Thou God seest me**: for she said, Have I also here looked after him that seeth me?"
- The God of Knowledge רְבִּיֹלֵ בְיֹבְיֹלֵ "El De'ot" <u>1st Samuel 2:3: -</u> "Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let *not* arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD *is* a **God of knowledge**, and by him actions are weighed."
- The God of Glory בְּבֶּבֶל "El Hakkovod" <u>Psalm 29:3: -</u> "The voice of the LORD *is* upon the waters: the God of glory thundereth: the LORD *is* upon many waters."
- The God of Heaven בְּיִשְׁיִבְיּה 'El Hashamayim' Psalm 136:26: "O give thanks unto **the God of heaven**: for his mercy *endureth* for ever."
- The God of my Life "T" 'S' "El Chaiyai" Psalm 42:8: "Yet the LORD will command his lovingkindness in the daytime, and in the night his song shall be with me, and my prayer unto the God of my life."
- The God of Israel אֵל יִשְׂרָאֵל **"El Yisrael"** <u>Psalm 68:35: -</u> "O God, *thou art* terrible out of thy holy places: **the God of Israel** *is* he that giveth strength and power unto *his* people. Blessed *be* God."
- God my Rock⁷ לֹאֵ סַעְּלְיֹּל **"El Sali"** <u>Psalm 42:9: -</u> "I will say unto **God my rock**, Why hast thou forgotten me? why go I mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?"
- The God of my Salvation בְּלֵאֶ יִיְיִשְׁוּעָתָ "El Yeshuati" <u>Isaiah 12:2: -</u> "Behold, **God** *is* **my salvation;** I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH *is* my strength and *my* song; he also is become my salvation."
- The God of our Salvation אַהֶל יִשׁוֹּעָבוּל "HaEl Yeshuatenu" Psalm 68:19: "Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah."

Proverbs 15:3: - "The eyes of the LORD are in every place, beholding the evil and the good."

⁶ We cannot hide our behaviour from God's eyes. He truly does see everything we do.

⁷ Jesus Christ is identified by the inspired Apostle Paul, as being that Rock [that is, the Rock Who was with the children of Israel in their wilderness wanderings].

¹st Corinthians 10:4: - "And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ."

• Immanuel – God with us⁸ - אֵלֶ לְּלֵּאָ **- "Immanu El"** - <u>Isaiah 7:14: -</u> "Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name **Immanuel.**"

OTHER HEBREW NAMES OF GOD: -

• The LORD9 - הְּרָּבְּ". • "Jehovah" – Exodus 6:2 & 3: - "And God spake unto Moses, and said unto him, I am *the LORD: And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them."

NOTE: - The margin has in VS. 2 for "the LORD", "Or, JEHOVAH".

- I AM THAT I AM¹0 הְאָרָהֶיָ אֲלֶּעֶר י"Eh'yeh 'Asher 'Eh'yeh" Exodus 3:14 & 15: "And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you. And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations."
- The LORD Who Sanctifies you בְּהֶנֶה מְלֵקְלִי, "Jehovah m'qadish'kem" Exodus 31:13: "Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I am the LORD that doth sanctify you."
- THE LORD my Banner יְהֹנֶה נִיסְ "Jehovahnissi" Exodus 17:15 & 16: "And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it *Jehovahnissi: For he said, Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have war with Amalek from generation to generation."

NOTE: - The margin has for "Jehovahnissi" in VS. 15, "Or, The LORD my banner: See Judg. 6:24".

• The LORD is Peace¹¹ - בְּבֶּהְ בֹּיִי - "Jehovahshalom" - <u>Judges 6:24: -</u> "Then Gideon built an altar there unto the LORD, and **called it *Jehovahshalom:** unto this day it *is* yet in Ophrah of the Abiezrites."

<u>NOTE:</u> *The margin has for "Jehovahshalom", "i. e. *The LORD send peace:* See Gen. 22:14, Ex. 17:15, Jer. 33:16, Ezek. 48:35."

• The LORD will See or Provide - בְּרֶבֶה הֹרֶבְיִּ - "Jehovahjireh" - Genesis 22:13 & 14: - "And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son. And Abraham called the name of that place *Jehovahjireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen."

NOTE: - *The margin has in VS. 14 for "Jehovahjireh", "i. e. The LORD will see, or, provide".

John 8:58: - "Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am."

Acts 10:36: - "The word which God sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ: (he is Lord of all:)"

⁸ Immanuel is defined as, "they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us" - Matthew 1:23.

⁹ The word "JEHOVAH" appears four times in the KJV Old Testament Scriptures: - Exodus 6:3; Psalm 83:18; Isaiah 12:2; Isaiah 26:4.

- The LORD Who Heals you דְּהֶלֶה, רֹפְאָּאָ "Jehovah Roph'ek" Exodus 15:26: "And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee."
- The LORD is there הַבְּילֵי הְיֹהְי "Jehovah-shammah" Ezekiel 48:35: "It was round about eighteen thousand measures: and the name of the city from that day shall be, The* LORD is there."

NOTE: - *The margin has for "The LORD is there", "Heb. Jehovah-shammah: See Ex.17:15, Judg 6:24".

- The LORD of Hosts¹² הַרָּבְּיִ בְּיִבְיּ "Jehovah Ts'ba'oth" <u>1st Samuel 17:45: -</u> "Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied."
- The LORD is my Shepherd¹³ יֻהֹלֶה יֹלִילִי "Jehovah Ro`i" <u>Psalm 23:1: -</u> "The LORD *is* my shepherd; I shall not want."
- The LORD of Recompense¹⁴ יְהְנֶה לֹּגְלֵיׁ "Jehovah--G'mul" <u>Jeremiah 51:6:</u> "Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this *is* the time of the **LORD'S** vengeance; he will render unto her a recompense."
- The LORD our Righteousness יְבְּרָבְּוֹלֵ "Jehovah-tsidkenu" Jeremiah 23:5 & 6: "Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, "THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS."

NOTE: - *The margin has in VS. 6 for "THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS", "Heb. Jehovah-tsidkenu".

Isaiah 47:4: - "As for our redeemer, the LORD of hosts is his name, the Holy One of Israel."

<u>Jeremiah 10:16:</u> - "The portion of Jacob *is* not like them: for he *is* the former of all *things*; and Israel *is* the rod of his inheritance: **The LORD of hosts** *is* **his name.**"

<u>Jeremiah 32:18:</u> - "Thou showest lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompensest the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the Mighty God, **the LORD of hosts**, *is* **his name**."

See also: - Isaiah 48:2; 51:15; 54:5; Jeremiah 31:35; 48:15; 50:34; 51:19.

John 10:11: - "I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep."

- The Ancient of Days¹⁷ בְּלֵלֶילְ יוֹבֶלֶילְ "'`Atiq Yomin" <u>Daniel 7:9 & 10: -</u> "I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened."

Its vowels are found in the Massoretic Text with the unpronounceable tetragrammaton "YHWH"; and when the Hebrew reader came to these letters, he always substituted in pronunciation the word "adhonay." Its vowels combined with the tetragrammaton form the word "Yahweh (Yahweh)." – International Standard Bible Encyclopedia – "Adonai". - https://www.biblestudytools.com/dictionary/adonai/ - Accessed 25/09/2020.

In the Old Testament Scriptures, אֲדֹנֵי - "Adonay" is described as being the Lord of lords.

Nehemiah 9:5: - "Then the Levites, Jeshua, and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, and Pethahiah, said, Stand up and bless the LORD your God for ever and ever: and blessed be thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise."
